- 3. Submit ACT or Accuplacer test scores (taken within the last three (3) years). The Accuplacer exam may be taken Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. until 11 a.m. in the NWTI Testing Center. There is a \$10.00 fee. The Accuplacer exam can also be taken multiple testing sites throughout Northwest Arkansas. Please check with your local college or high school for testing information.
