Q. When is open enrollment?

A. We offer about 6 courses a year. The Allied Health Admissions office in room 116 will have a current list of dates and times. Application packet is due 2 weeks prior to the start date or until the class is full.

Q. What is considered a complete packet?

A. A complete packet includes the all required documents: application, accuplacer), immunization records, and one job reference letter.

Q. How long is the course?

A. CNA classes vary between 4 or 8 week classes. The four week classes are full days, M-Th from 8-4:30 p.m. The 8 week classes are typically Monday and Thursday only 8-430 p.m. Please check with allied health admissions for additional information on starting dates and times.
