License Practical Nursing

Q. When is open enrollment and when is the start date?

A. We accept applications from August 1st to November 1st^h. The start date is in the spring semester, January.

Q. What is considered a complete packet?

A. A complete packet includes the required documents: application, copy of your ID, social security card, and CNA certification, Next-Generation Accuplacer scores, official High School /official GED Scores, official college transcripts, immunization records, and job reference letters.

Q. How long is the course?

A. 18 months, the course starts in the spring (January) and ends the following year in the summer (June).

Q. Is financial aid available?

- A. Yes, financial aid is available and you may obtain information from the Student Services Department.
- Q. How many people are accepted into the program?
- A. The program accepts 50 students.
- Q. How is the selection for each class determined?

A. You must have a CNA certification before entering the LPN program. The process is based on a scoring system, which includes scores from the Accuplacer tests and an interview with the Director of Nursing.

Q. When and where is the Accuplacer test given?

A. The test is administered in room 130. The cost of the Accuplacer test is \$10. Appointment is needed and can be scheduled by calling 479-751-8824 ext. 0 or ext. 116

Q. How will I know if I am accepted into the program that I chose?

- A. You will be notified by mail.
- Q. If I am not selected, do I need to reapply?

A. Yes, you will need to reapply and complete another application along with work references or personal references.

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
