CDL Training Checklist

The following are required to register for Class A or Class B CDL classes at NWTI:

CDL Class A or Class B Learner's Permit

To get your CDL Class A or Class B Learner's License you must purchase the \$50 CDL packet from the DMV (Department of Motor Vehicles) **and** pass the CDL Class A or Class B Written Learner's Permit Exam at the Lowell, Arkansas State Police Testing Site. You must bring in a physical copy of your CDL Learner's Permit to register for the CDL driving training at NWTI.

DOT (Department of Transportation) Physical

To get your DOT Physical, you must have an exam by a licensed medical examiner that is listed on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) National Registry. You must provide a physical copy of your DOT physical to register for the CDL driving training at NWTI.

Register for the NWTI CDL Driver Training Program

To register, please complete the NWTI CDL Class Registration form **at least 5 days prior to the start of class**. Once you are registered, you will be enrolled in a 15-hour online theory training class that must be completed prior to the start of the program.
